Tommy Sipsy

Tommy Sipsy is the Chief Fire & Explosion Investigator for Corporate Security Southern Company Gas where he has been employed for the past 34 years. Tommy worked most of his time in the field performing service work, managing operations, and Managing Construction, before moving over to his current role. Tommy is in his final year of working on a bachelor's Degree in Fire Science, with a major in Fire, Arson, and Explosion from Eastern Kentucky University. In his current role as Chief Investigator he spends much of his time investigating fires and explosions with public sector and private sector investigators, along with assisting with the testing of the natural gas systems in or around a premise. Over the last 34 years he has been able to obtain valuable knowledge on NFPA 54 and CFR 49.192 fuel gas codes & regulations. Tommy has obtained Georgia Certified Arson Investigator Level I & II, National Association of Fire Investigators CFEI, International Association of Arson Investigators CFI, FIT, & ECT certifications and is currently a Fannin County Volunteer Firefighter. Mr. Sipsy teaches a 4-hour block on Fuel Gas Investigations at Arson Level II conducted at The Georgia Public Service Training Center in Forsyth Georgia.
