Topic

Understanding AC Interference & Mitigation Solutions

The complex interaction between collocated pipelines and high-voltage AC power transmission systems demands strategic, cost-effective mitigation designs that meet the twin challenges of personnel safety and pipeline protection. Understanding the critical role of AC current density in an AC interference situation is central to the corrosion professional's consideration of mitigation options. As such, this session will address the selection, installation and use of coupon test stations including an in-depth discussion of AC current density, AC potentials, DC current density, DC potentials and installation best practices including remote monitoring solutions.

We will also have a special presentation by Alicia Yust, Senior Manager in Education at NACE International, who will begin this meeting with a short overview of the new NACE Ethics courses.
