
All meetings will be in-person only starting in August.

Matt has led a wide variety of natural gas distribution and transmission pipeline projects and has extensive experience with metering and regulating (M&R) stations, from inception and design review through construction. He specializes in budget planning/ forecasting, design and construction services, commissioning and decommissioning, and the analysis and identification of maintenance considerations. Matt's experience also includes large-scale pipeline replacement programs; public and private agency-driven relocations; new service lines, meters, mains, and associated system improvements; pressure improvements; and pressure modeling and GIS systems.
